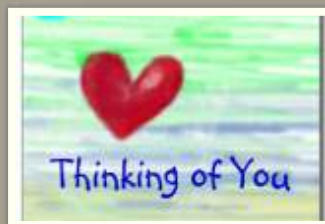
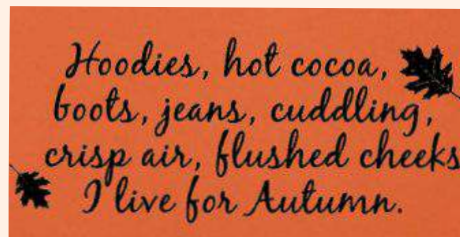

## Dream Factory is October Charity of the Month

In 1980, The Dream Factory began with one all-volunteer chapter in Hopkinsville, Kentucky. Since then, it has grown into the second-largest children's wish-granting organization in the U.S., granting over 25,000 dreams since its inception. The Dream Factory continues to operate all 36 of its local chapters with over 5000 very dedicated volunteers. These hard-working individuals raise funds within their own communities and then use those funds to grant the dreams of local children. Because they do not employ people on a local level, 84% of all money raised goes directly toward granting the dreams of critically and chronically ill children.

The Dream Factory is the only children's wish-granting organization that does not limit its mission to children with life-threatening illness. They believe children with chronic illnesses and disorders also suffer from substantial emotional and physical pain. The organization strives to provide hope and relief from the trauma and corresponding stress and depression that both the children and their families can endure on a day-to-day basis. Doctors agree that providing a dream can improve the quality of life for these children and extend the life of a critically ill child.

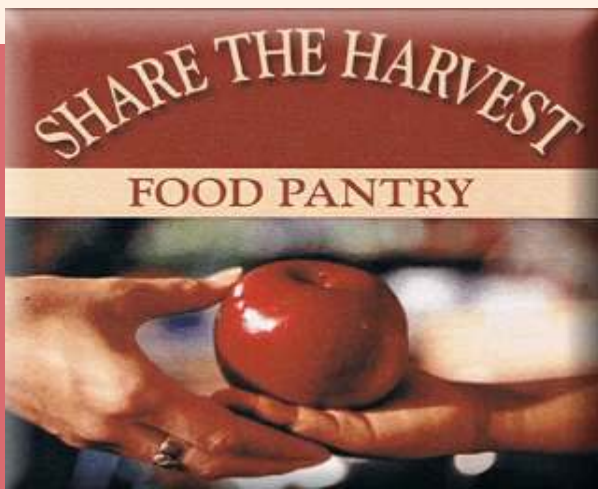
## UNIQUE BOUTIQUE COMING SOON! Open to the Public for the First Time

## Introducing the President's Charities

Share the Harvest Food Pantry and Resale Nook exists to strengthen the family unit by connecting people in need to food and other resources to meet their needs. They are committed to working with families to help them maintain a food-secure, safe, warm environment whereby all members of a family are provided an opportunity to thrive. Share the Harvest Food Pantry is currently now serving over 1,000 families (3,000 people) each month, using 80,000 pounds of food monthly. In the past eight years they have distributed 2,880,000 pounds. Fifty percent of the food comes from the food bank of Central & NE Missouri, 35% from local grocery stores and 15% from the local community.

The "Twice Around Clothing and Furniture Nook" operates in conjunction with Share the Harvest and provides the community with affordable merchandise to the general public. The revenue generated through the sale of donated items is used to support the on-going work of Share the Harvest Food Pantry.

"Look into the faces of our communities neediest people. Yes, you'll see the weary men struggling with alcohol and other addictions. But look again. You'll also see battered wives fleeing domestic terror. You'll see responsible, employed parents forced to choose between paying rent and buying groceries. You'll see entire families whose lives were shattered when their jobs disappeared. This is why we exist, to help the needy in our community."
