

## ***Who Benefits from the Home Tour?***

Each year the President selects local charities and scholarships to benefit from our N/L Home Tour. The proceeds from this year's events will be awarded to:



**Citizens Against Domestic Violence/ Victim Outreach Center (CADV/ VOC )** in the Lake of the Ozarks community serves victims of domestic and sexual violence primarily in Camden, Miller, and Morgan Counties

for over 20 years. Services include: crisis intervention, 24 hour hot line, safe shelter, court advocacy, support groups, and assistance with emergency items utilizing an active volunteer corps overseen by a Volunteer Coordinator. A new 28 bed shelter opened in February 2013. Call CADV at 573-346-9630 for volunteer opportunities.



**Share the Harvest Food Pantry's** mission is to help feed the hungry in Camden County. Located in Greenview, MO, it began serving 100 families in 2005. Ten years later, 1000 families are helped each month. Revenues from the Thrift Store, opened in 2007, help sustain the Food Pantry. A Board of Directors, staff, and volunteers are vital to the Food Pantry which is open three days a

week and one evening. The Thrift Store is open six days a week and one evening. Private and public grants enabled Share the Harvest to construct a new 13,000 sq. ft. building which was finished in 2011 to house the Food Pantry and Thrift Store. A high tunnel garden was built in 2013 where fresh organic produce is grown year round. Share the Harvest Food Pantry and Thrift Store can be reached at 573-873-5855.
