



# Spickerdoodle Cookies Soft & Chewy

### **Ingredients**

1 c. salted butter-2 sticks soften

1 1/3 c. sugar

1/3 c. brown sugar-packed

2 eggs

2 t. vanilla

 $3\frac{1}{4}$  c. all-purposed flour, spooned & leveled

1 t. baking soda

 $\frac{3}{4}$  t. kosher salt

 $1\frac{1}{2}$  t. cream of tartar

### For rolling

1/3 c. sugar

 $1\frac{1}{2}$  T. cinnamon

### Instructions



Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Mix the dough: In a large bowl, beat butter. Add sugar & brown sugar. Beat for 2 minutes. Then add eggs & vanilla. Beat well. Next, add flour, baking soda, salt, & cream of tartar. Beat together but don't over mix. Over mixing dough=tough cookies. Then use a medium spoon to shape dough into balls.

Roll the cookies: In a small bowl, add sugar & cinnamon. Mix together. Next, roll the shaped cookie balls in the Cinnamon/Sugar to coat. Place cookie balls on the prepared baking sheet (lined with parchment paper) 2 inches in between.

Bake the cookies: At 350 for about 9-11 minutes, until the edges are barely set. It's VERY important to not over bake snickerdoodles. Let the cookies rest on the cookies sheet for 3-5 minutes. Remove the cookies to a cooling rack and cool for a few minutes. While the cookies are still warm, place each cookie back into the cinnamon-sugar. Coat one side of cookie, then flip over and coat the other side. This gives you the ultimate cinnamon-sugar edge to your snickerdoodle!
